



(U) August 2023 Intimate Partner Violence Lethality Assessment Protocol Update



(U) LAP Data - August 2023¹

(U) In August 2023 there were 1,015 Intimate Partner Violence Lethality Assessment Protocols (LAPs) submitted by 106 agencies. This represents a 13% decrease in submissions from the prior month. 64% (651) of the August LAPs were assessed as potentially lethal, while 32% (328) were assessed as not potentially lethal. The top 5 counties for LAP Submissions were Salt Lake (47%), Utah (14%), Davis (10%), Weber (6%), and Washington (4.5%). The top 5 law enforcement agencies that submitted LAPs were Salt Lake City PD (13%), West Valley City PD (10%), Unified PD (7%), West Jordan PD (5%), and Sandy City PD (4%).

(U) LAPs were most frequently submitted on Thursdays and between the hours of 2100 to 2359 hrs.

(U) Per the questionnaire, victims most often reported (61%) that the aggressor is violently or constantly jealous, or controls most of the daily activities of the victim. 55% of the time victims reported that they have left or are separated from the aggressor after cohabitating or marriage.
