Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity

Within the governor's office, we lead and coordinate the economic development efforts in Utah

- Approximately 100 state workers
- 20+ offices and programs
- Statewide presence from Logan to St. George; from Fillmore to Moab; and everything in between
- \$240 million annual budget (FY 2023)



Business Services

APEX Accelerator

Annual APEX client base approximately 800 small and medium sized Utah businesses.
 Assisted Utah businesses to win over \$1B in government procurement contracts

Utah Innovation Center

 Helped clients win approximately \$9M in Phase I SBIR/STTR research and development grants and over \$30M in Phase II grants (non-dilutive; researchers keep ownership/equity)

Utah Center for Immigration & Integration

 Provided resources and assistance to 100+ businesses and individuals; convened 150 stakeholders to inform and make recommendations on immigration and New American integration in Utah supporting the >11.2% foreign born workforce participation in Utah


Utah Small Business Credit Initiative

• U.S Treasury authorized GOEO to administer \$69M in lending for Utah small businesses

Incentives & Grants

- Awarded approximately **\$150M** in grants or incentives to Utah businesses in FY 2023 resulting in approximately **340** contracts.
- Grants totaling approximately \$43M went to rural Utah businesses and communities
- The Utah Broadband Center awarded approximately \$973,000 to 34 organizations
 including state and local government entities and educational, nonprofit, and tribal groups
- Approved a post performance tax reduction agreement with Texas Instruments
 Incorporated (TI) to add 800 new, high-tech jobs and invest \$11 billion in Utah. This
 investment is the largest economic investment in Utah history

International Trade & Diplomacy

- GOEO, in partnership with World Trade Center Utah, organized a trade mission to France and the United Kingdom for nearly 100 government, business, and community leaders - two of Utah's largest trade markets
- Facilitated two trade agreements one with Région Sud of France and one with the United Kingdom
- Hosted 36 delegations from 42 countries and international organizations
- Hosted over 50 dignitaries and international representatives



Operations

Business Intelligence

 Standardize grant and incentive data management from design through execution ensuring data integrity and technical support across teams

Compliance

 Ensure applicant accountability with post performance requirements, confirm adherence to state and federal regulations, and facilitate issuance of tax certificates related to over 12 billion dollars in capital investment

Finance

 Process accounting transactions for a \$240 million annual budget (FY 2023), manage over 650 active contracts, oversee travel for 100+ staff, and maintain policies and procedures for all financial efforts within the office

Office Management

 Coordinate all actions with Human Resources for onboarding of new staff, manage facilities and reception needs, gather and organize resources for staff needs

Strategic Initiatives

Unified Economic Opportunity Commission

 Developed more than 50 policy initiatives consolidated into 19 bills and 12 requests for appropriation that totaled more than \$1B of investment

Utah Office of Regulatory Relief

 Had two organizations graduate from sandbox participation resulting in a new bill passing during the 2023 legislative session

Center for Rural Development

 Created the Outreach Manager service model. These managers work with Utah's rural counties, communities, and businesses, providing economic development resources.

Targeted Industries

 Executed 7 roundtable discussions with the Governor and industry leaders. Discussing issues regarding state policy, regulations, ecosystem gaps, workforce needs, etc.

Utah Office of Tourism & Film

- The Office of Tourism campaigns for southern
 Utah and skiing recorded approximately 1.23
 million Utah leisure trips and \$2.77B in visitor
 spending, resulting in over \$223M in state and
 local taxes
- The Utah Board of Tourism Development approved more than \$5.2M in cooperative marketing matching funds from the Tourism Marketing Performance Fund for 59 projects in 24 of Utah's 29 counties
- \$18.79 million in state film incentives was awarded in FY 2023 to 17 productions shooting in Utah, including a mix of local and out-of-state feature films and TV series, yielding a total estimated spend of \$140 million
