Federal and Non-Federal Funds Report November 14, 2023

HIGHLIGHTS:

Federal Grant Applications Requiring Legislative Action

Twenty-four grants, totaling \$45,541,897 require approval from the Executive Appropriations Committee. Nine of the grants require an additional \$2,404,294 of state matching funding, which will be covered by existing program expenses. Eleven of the grants are new and the remaining thirteen are continuations or reapplications.

New Federal Grant - 11 Federal Grant Continuation or Reapplication - 13

Federal Grant Applications Approved by the Governor's Office

Twenty-six grants, totaling **\$8,752,143** have been approved by the Governor's Office. None of the grants have matching requirements. Seventeen of the grants are new and the remaining nine are continuations, reapplications, or supplemental authority for grants exceeding 125% of appropriations.
