Department Mission & Vision

Mission

To protect the financial security of people and businesses in Utah

Vision

An insurance market that is regulated fairly and accessible to all Utahns



What We're Requesting Today:

- Increase in the Fraud Assessment on Insurers
- Increase in the Insurer Service Fee
- *No impact on the General Fund*

What the Fee Increases Will Pay For:

- 4 new FTEs
- Higher-priced legal services from the Attorney General's Office
- Raises for insurance fraud investigators whose pay is below market rate



Insurance Industry

Insurance Premium Volume Growth in Utah

- *\$24.9 billion* written in 2022
- *\$22.6 billion* written in 2021
- 57% growth over last 5 years

Utah's Insurance Industry is a Top Contributor

- Contributed \$192 million in premium taxes to the General Fund in FY23; 43% increase since FY18 (5-year)
- Paid \$19 million in fees, assessments, and penalties in FY23 to fund the UID budget; excess goes to the General Fund



UID FY25 Budget Requests

Financial Regulator - \$142,000 ongoing for 1.0 FTE

- Eliminated due to Covid budget cuts in 2020; BEDL approved restoration in 2023 GS but removed from budget by EAC
- Restoration will save money because a contract regulator costs twice as much as a UID regulator

Property & Casualty Market Conduct Examiners - \$256,000 ongoing for 2.0 FTE

- Workload increase of 50% for consumer complaints has created the need for more market conduct examiners
- Funding the positions will ensure that consumers receive timely help

Research Consultant - \$155,000 ongoing for 1.0 FTE

 This research consultant will help ensure accurate and complete development of health insurance reports based on increased statutory data collections from insurers and pharmacy drug manufacturers



UID FY25 Budget Requests/Issues

Fee Increase - Insurance Fraud Assessment and Insurance Service Fee

• Fee increase for Insurance Fraud Investigation Restricted Account and the Insurance Department Administration Restricted Account

Attorney General ISF Adjustment - \$115,000 ongoing (civil), \$300,000 ongoing (criminal) appropriations

 Appropriation adjustment to align with cost increases in both civil and criminal areas for the UID (no effect on the General Fund).

Fraud Investigator Salary Increase

- \$210,000 ongoing increase from the Insurance Fraud Investigation Restricted Account (no effect on the General Fund).
- To meet the growing costs of public safety staff

State Mandated Insurer Payments (currently for Autism coverage)

- \$1,222,000 ongoing General Fund increase recommended to cover all payments for upcoming fiscal year
- The state-mandated insurer payments are a pass through for the UID and a separate line item from their operational budget.
