## Disabled Veteran Parking Amendments

- Allows certain Veterans or service members with a disability to obtain a specialty license plate or windshield placard on a permanent basis
- Reduced redundancy and maximizes efficiency of State agencies
- While there are 150,000 Veterans in Utah, there are less than 3,000 Disabled Veteran designated plates
- This bill also encourages State and Government buildings to designate Veteran specific parking spaces near the ADA parking spaces as an added convenience to Veterans that are not disabled
- This bill is supported by both the Utah Office of Veteran Affairs and the Utah Disability Law Center
