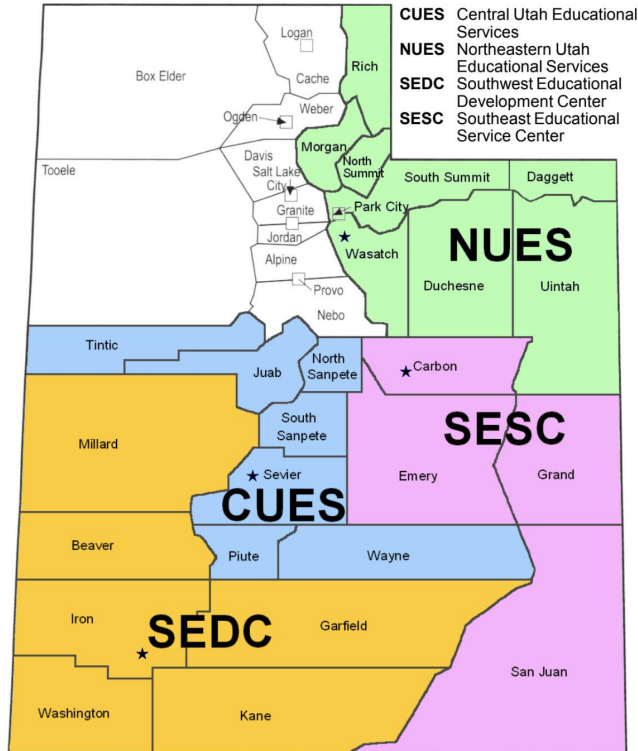

Creating Economy of Scale

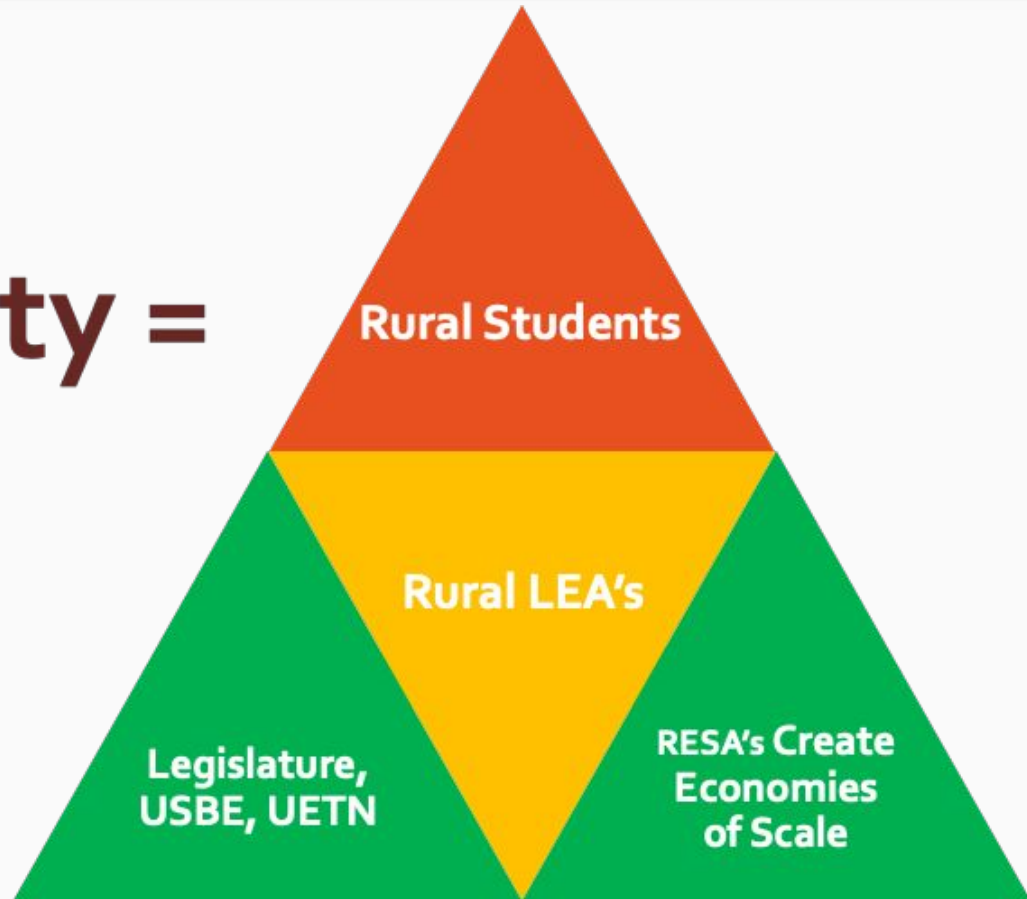


Regional Education Service Agencies



- Created in 1969 (SB3) by the Utah State Legislature to support 26 rural school districts in four regions across the State to create economies of scale.
- 2020 Session (SB 79) Created RESAs as new education entity (53E-3-401)
- RESAs granted authority to provide services to students and to apply for LEA grants
- Access LEA programs and systems through USBE and the State

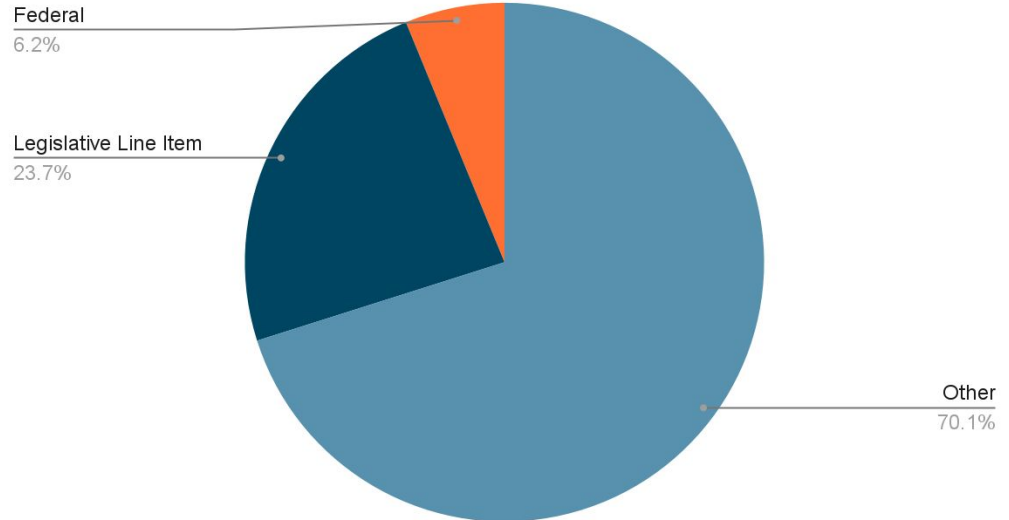

Other (Local LEAs, Grants, UETN)	\$1,565,197
Federal	\$138,500
Total	\$2,232,447

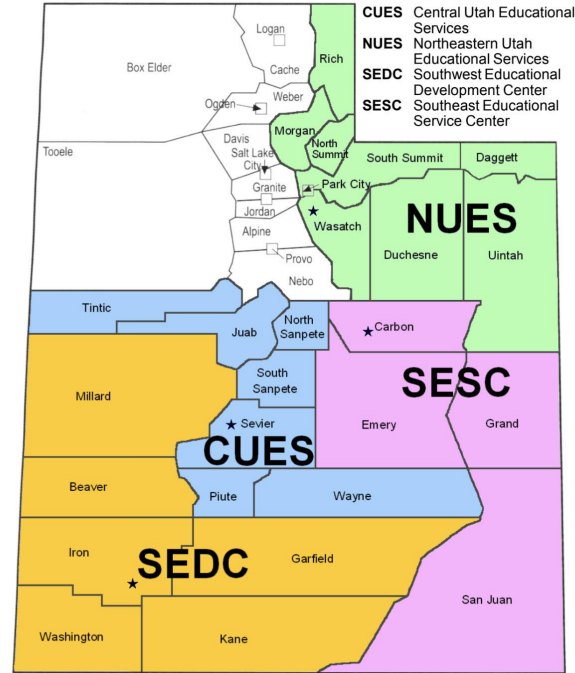
Funding Sources
