Line-Item Overview




Utah has four **Regional Education Service Agencies (RESAs)** comprised of rural school districts and charter schools. The regional service centers are meant to provide equitable and cost-effective services and programs. The specific services they provide are determined by the member LEAs. In general, the service centers provide professional development (endorsements and training), technology (support, hosting, installation, and purchasing), media (eBooks and duplication), student services (Sterling Scholar and online drivers education), and administration (grant writing, cooperative purchasing, and coordination).
