Who would benefit from this request (who is the target audience)?

This request is intended to conserve water by eliminating non-functional turf and helping replace that with more water efficient landscaping like trees and shrubs. It helps people who want to make that change.

What is this project or program intended to accomplish?

This project removes non-functional turf to conserve water.

How will the Legislature know whether the project or program achieved its intended purpose?

The legislature has the capacity to track how many projects have been funded to remove turf, how much turf has been removed, and how much water was being allocated to this turf. Water metering allows the water allocated to sections of turf to be tracked so the Legislature can produce quantifiable outcome data.

Section 5: Other Supporting Documents

Intent Language

The legislature intends that \$12,500,000 from the General Fund provided by this item be used for turf removal. This funding will be appropriated to the Utah Department of Natural Resources Division of Water Resources which will then distribute funds to local water districts to supplement their funds used for turf removal.

Previous State Funding

Last legislative session (fiscal year 2023) the legislature allocated \$3,000,000 ongoing and \$5 million one time to turf removal. This funding was overseen by the Utah Department of Natural Resources Division of Water Resources.
