Page 1. Lines 14 through 15:

requires the Department of Transportation to register any aircraft operating in the

15 state for a certain period each year, with certain exceptions;

Page 5, Lines 145 through 150:

145 (b) The restriction described in Subsection (1)(a) does not apply to:

(i) aircraft licensed by

146 a foreign country with which the United States has a reciprocal agreement covering the

147 operations of the registered aircraft { or to };

(ii) a non-passenger-carrying flight solely for inspection

148 or test purposes authorized by the Federal Aviation Administration to be made without the

149 certificate of registration{...}; or (iii) aircraft operating under 14 CFR 121 with a maximum takeoff weight exceeding 60,000 pounds.
