



#### **2023 Utah State Fair** Performance Review

- 2023 Attendance: 320,967
  - KBI Goal 5% increase over prior year.
  - Achieved 130% of goal.
  - 77,000 people visited the fair on the second Saturday

#### • 3,987 Competitive Art Exhibit Entries

- 26% increase over prior year
- 2729 Livestock Exhibitors
- Carnival ride & Midway Revenue: \$2,215,320.00
  - 12% increase over prior year

## **2023 Fair Shuttle Bus Service**

- For the first time in our history, we activated two remote parking lots.
- Our intent was to perform a beta test to collect consumer feedback needed to better understand their appetite for offsite parking
- One lot offered free employee parking the second lot offered guest parking at ½ the cost of on-sight parking.
- We operated four shuttle busses that offered 15minute door to door service from 6:00am to midnight Sunday through Thursday. And 6:00am to 1:30am Friday and Saturday
- Over 10,000 guest and employees took advantage of the remote lots. The overwhelming response was very positive.












## **10 Year History of Revenue & Profit**
