Funding Request Description

The Utah Department of Agriculture and Food is requesting \$154,000 in ongoing funding for salary and benefits for a laboratory diagnostician at the Spanish Fork Branch Laboratory (SFBL) of the Utah Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory. This position will replace the Utah state poultry extension specialist who was located at SFBL until his retirement.

- Provides veterinary diagnostic services for the state
- Mission: animal health, agricultural economy, public zoonosis

- Molecular Diagnostics
- Faster response to outbreaks in the Southern half of the state
- Plans for future National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN)
 accreditation



Summary

- Lab is currently understaffed, resulting in decreased capabilities and increased wait times for results
- Fast results are critical to stop the spread of disease, facilitate animal movement, and improve treatment outcomes
- Veterinary support will be essential to support the laboratory expansion planned for 2024-2025
