CANYONLANDS FIELD INSTITUTE

- Founded in 1984
- Educational rafting trips and field study programs
- Immersive outdoor educational adventure for 6th through 12th grade students
- The Professor Valley Field Camp is located on 40 acres of desert wilderness (20 miles from Moab)



OUTDOOR LEARNING IMPROVES ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

- Provides a hands-on curriculum that meets state standards of science and complements math, art, history, and writing.
- Activities emphasize data collection, problem-solving, and social and emotional learning through experience to supplement classroom-based learning.
- Students report a greater sense of personal responsibility and comfort while speaking in a group setting.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Three days and two nights of immersive outdoor education led by naturalist guides. Food, up to date curriculum, and outfitting services are all included.
- Includes a whitewater Rafting trip on the Moab Daily section of the Colorado River.
- As little as \$416 per student per trip; up to 60 students per group

PILOT PROGRAM

- In the first year, CFI wants to bring in four 6th grade groups (up to 60 in each group) from around Utah.
- M. Lynn Bennion Elementary and Northwest Middle have arranged to come to in May.
- Funding will help with two additional schools.
