### **Section 1: Request Details**

#### **Description:**

The Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands shall administer a one-time grant(s) of \$5,000,000 to protect and restore wetlands and habitats of the Great Salt Lake for the benefit of the Lake. The Division shall complete an analysis to determine the infrastructure and engineering needs related to salinity management, hydrologic improvements within the meander line of Great Salt Lake, and consult with the Division of Wildlife Resources to identify projects on sovereign lands that benefit wildlife habitat through the improved flow of water and management of both native and invasive plant species with a one-time appropriation of \$500,000. Pursuant to authority vested within the Division, in 65A-10-203 the Division shall work to improve the conditions of wetlands and protect wildlife habitat and may increase capacity to do so with ongoing funding of \$500,000. A one time appropriation of \$1,000,000 shall be used for the removal of invasive species, and/or the restoration and enhancement of the riparian and wetland areas of Bear Lake and Utah Lake (\$500,000 for Utah Lake, and \$500,000 for Bear Lake).
