Page 4, Lines 102 through 113: 1. (a) A violation of Subsection (2) or (3) is a class C misdemeanor and the minimum 102 103 penalty is: (i) for a first offense: 104 105 (A) \$1,000; and 106 (B) { no less than 50 } 10 hours of compensatory service; 107 (ii) for a second offense within five years of a previous conviction or bail forfeiture: 108 (A) \$2,000; and 109 (B) { no less than 200 hours and up to 400 } 20 hours of compensatory service; and

(iii) for a third or subsequent offense within five years of a previous conviction or bail 110

111 forfeiture:

112 (A) \$3,000; and

113 (B) {no less than 200 hours and up to 400 } 40 hours of compensatory service.
