- 28 [(i)] (a) (i) the entire case was dismissed;
- 29 (ii) there is no appeal pending for the case; and
- 30 (iii) at least [three years] {90} 120 days have passed from the day on which the eviction was
- 31 [filed] dismissed; or
- 32 (b) the parties to the eviction stipulated to expungement and have filed a stipulation
- 33 with the court.
