### **ECONOMIC IMPACT**

- . About **8.4%** of Utah jobs (146,260) are in, or indirectly supported by the cultural industry (69,820 direct jobs & 76,440 indirect jobs.)
- Utah's cultural industry generated \$6.8 **BILLION** in Gross Domestic Product (GDP), which is 2.6% of total GDP, in 2022
- Responsible for 12-13% of Utah's 2022 tourism.
- Generated an average of \$776-795 per travel party per trip for cultural/art trips.
