

# H.B. 362 JUVENILE JUSTICE REVISIONS

## BACKGROUND

**Amends language from the 2023 General Session, HB 304.**

Crimes committed by Utah's youth need to be quelled.

Nestor Del Valle, now 18 years old, was charged with two aggravated murder charges and has recently been tied to a third.

Police say that he was already well known in the juvenile justice system when these incidents occurred.



## KEY POLICY CHANGES

Updates the funding formula for the Juvenile Gang Prevention Grant Program.

Makes it a crime to solicit a minor to commit a criminal offense.

Clarifies possession of a dangerous weapon by a minor.

Requires a school employee to report offenses committed by a minor on school grounds or at a school sponsored activity.

Updates the reintegration plan for students alleged to have committed a serious offense.
