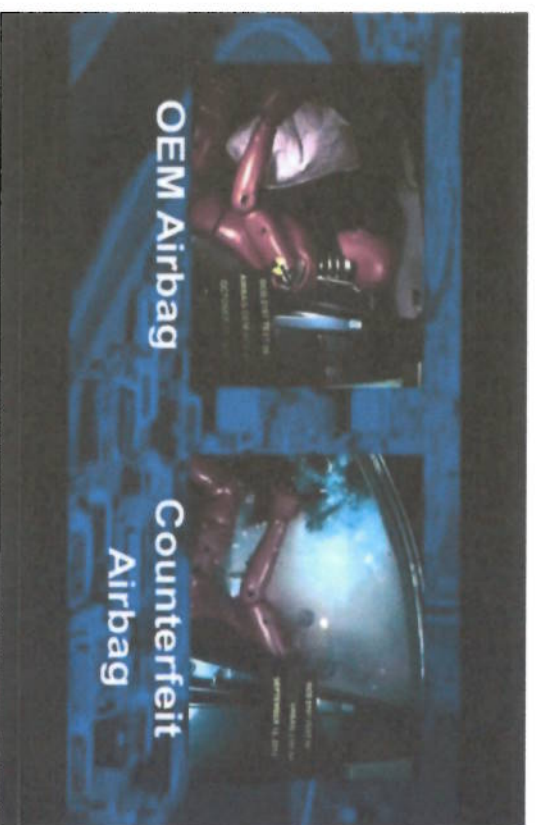
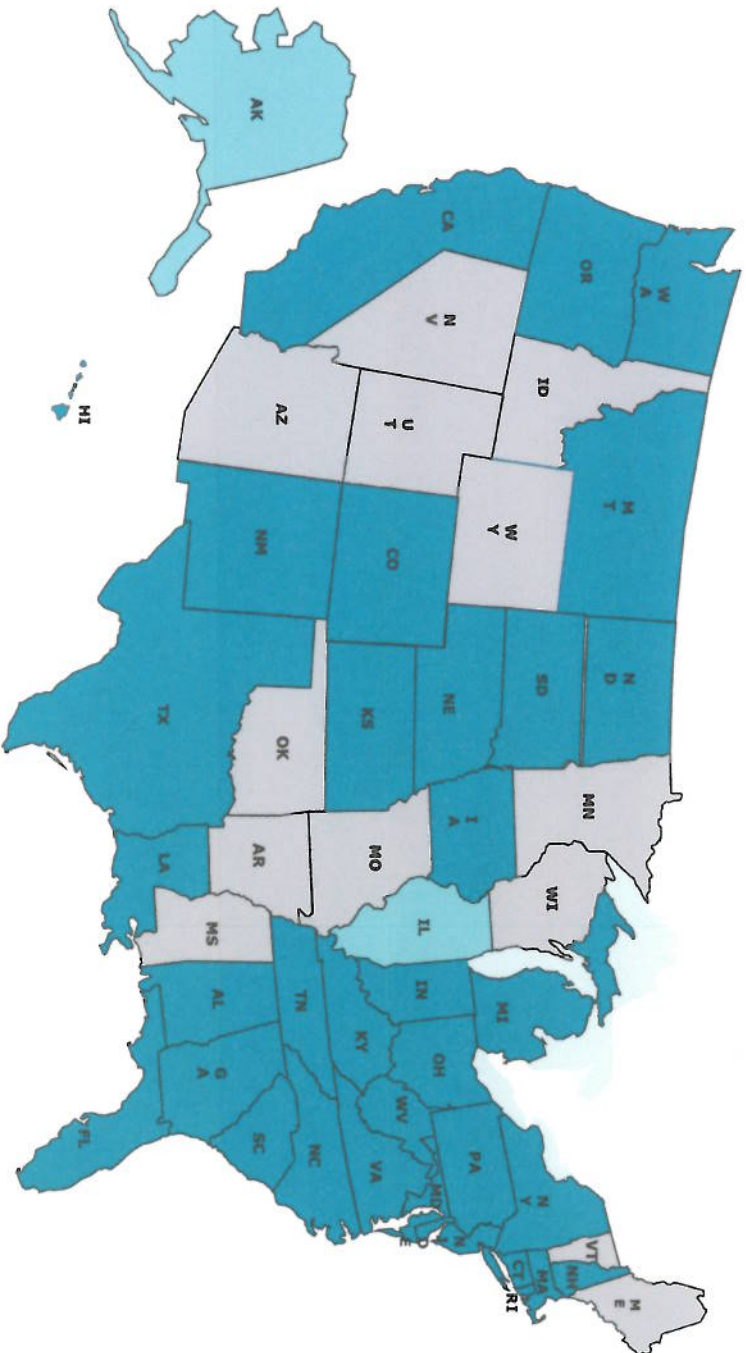


Counterfeit Airbags

- Over the past several years the auto industry has seen foreign and domestic counterfeiters flooding the market with **ineffective** counterfeit and **nonfunctional** airbags
- These airbags are not intended to provide protection in a collision
- Many are filled with newspaper, Styrofoam or other debris

Counterfeit Airbags

1. Commonsense safety legislation
2. May not inflate and may increase the risk of injury to passengers
3. Broad support including:
 - Automotive Anti-Counterfeiting Council (A2C2)
 - Dealers
 - Insurers
 - Automotive recyclers
 - Safety advocates
 - Law enforcement
