Amendment 1 S.B. 267

Page 2, Lines 42 through 46: 1.

42 (2) The division may, as funding permits and either directly or through one or more

43 third parties who are under contract with the division, provide overnight respite care services

- and, concurrent with the respite care services, services for the individual who is eligible to 44
- receive division services, such as recreational therapy, community-based programs, therapeutic 45

recreation, educational programs, transportation, or vocational rehabilitation. 46
