Background

This document compiles statutory provisions scheduled to be repealed between April 2025 and April 2026 under Title 63I, Oversight. Without legislative action in the 2025 General Session, the provisions will be repealed on the specified date.

Sunset Review Assignment Recommendations

The following provisions are scheduled to be repealed on the specified date under Title 63I, Chapter 1, Legislative Oversight and Sunset Act, unless extended during the 2025 General Session. **These provisions are subject to an interim committee sunset review.** The Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel recommends the following provisions be assigned to the specified interim committee.
