MANAGING CAPACITY



UDC is using a system-wide, multidisciplinary approach to increasing public safety by improving treatment in prison and in the community, an aggressive approach to eliminating drugs entering the prisons, and improving overall reentry services and leadership changes.



Immediate Action Plan

Goal: Create a capacity management plan that results in a net reduction of 20 individuals (or more) from both returns and releases each week, resulting in an annual capacity buffer of 1.560.

- 1. Capacity Management Team:
 Multidisciplinary team of staff
 working directly with inmates and
 parolees to develop a plan for
 simultaneously reducing the number
 of people returning to prison on
 Parole Violations and increasing the
 number of people releasing to parole.
- 2. Warrant and Prison Return Review:
 AP&P will require Region Chief Review
 of all BOPP warrants and prison
 returns. Ensure those who pose a
 significant threat to public safety are
 prioritized for return to prison and
 others are monitored safely in the
 community through other
 interventions and enhanced case
 management.
- 3. Active Reentry Planning:
 Reentry and Rehabilitation Case
 Managers will employ an active case
 management approach to ensure
 releases are maximized based on a
 12-month forward projection and
 planning system.
