KEY POINTS

- Many students require additional support for a variety of reasons.
- JSD has seen a 92.6% increase in English Learners over the last 6 years.
- Meeting the needs of English Learners is a new challenge to some schools, an ongoing challenge to others, and a growing challenge to Jordan School District.

ENGLISH LEARNER

A student whose native language is other than English, and who hasn't yet tested fluent in English on the WIDA test.

Does not include students already fluent in English + other languages upon enrollment



HOW ARE ENGLISH LEARNERS IDENTIFIED?

1. Registration

Parents answer questions from the federally required Home Language Survey (HLS) regarding primary language spoken.

2. WIDA Test

If the language is other than English, a WIDA test is given.

A student qualifies for English Learner services if their WIDA score does not meet the academic language fluency standard.

THE WIDA ASSESSMENT:

- Measures English learners' academic language acquisition and fluency.
- Is administered annually until English Learners meet the academic language fluency standard.



481 English learners met proficiency this year.






JSD ENGLISH LEARNER ENROLLMENT TRENDS

Bingham feeder schools have seen increases in English Learner enrollment, but not to the extent of other feeder systems.





Copper Hills feeder schools have seen significant increases in English Learner enrollment.











West Jordan feeder schools have typically had high English Learner enrollment and that trend continues.




JSD LOW ENGLISH FLUENCY COUNT






