Local Education Agency School Safety and Security Personnel Updates

The Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education has prepared the following report for the July 17, 2024 meeting¹ of the School Security Taskforce to summarize the progress of hiring the school safety and security personnel required under HB 84² at the following charter schools that are authorized by or have formal partnership arrangements with USHE institutions:

Academy for Math, Engineering, and Science (University of Utah)

- Relationship with the higher education institution: AMES was created in partnership with the University of Utah and Granite and Salt Lake City School Districts.³ AMES is physically located at Cottonwood High School in the Granite School District.
- <u>Grades:</u> 9-12
- 2023-2024 School Year Fall Enrollment: 469 students4

- Other safety and security personnel needs identified by the school safety needs assessment (53G-8-701.5(2)(a)(ii)⁷): AMES conducted its school safety needs assessment in conjunction with Cottonwood High School this summer. AMES is currently served by two School Resource Officers
 one from Murray Police Department who serves from 7:00 AM to 2:10 PM, and a Granite School Police Officer who serves from 11:00 AM until the school closes.

Northern Utah Academy for Math, Engineering, and Science: Davis and Ogden campuses (Weber State University)

- Relationship with the higher education institution: NUAMES is located on and partners with Weber State University.9
- Grades: 10-12
- 2023-2024 School Year Fall Enrollment: 713 students (Davis campus)¹⁰, 453 students (Ogden campus)¹¹

- Other safety and security personnel needs identified by the school safety needs assessment (53G-8-701.5(2)(a)(ii)): Although NUAMES is waiting to receive the School Safety Needs Assessment due in December, both campuses have completed a yearly emergency procedure required for all K12 schools. Currently, NUAMES also has a full-time resource officer at each campus: Brett Paulsen at the Davis campus (brettpaulsen@weber.edu) and Cameron Kapetanov at the Ogden campus (ameronkapetanov@weber.edu).

SUCCESS Academy: SUU and UT campuses (Southern Utah University, Utah Tech University)

- Relationship with the higher education institutions: SUCCESS Academy's charter is authorized by the Iron County School District and Washington School District. The charter leases space on the Southern Utah University and Utah Tech University campuses.¹²
- Grades: 9-12 (SUU campus), 10-12 (UT campus)
- <u>2023-2024 School Year Fall Enrollment:</u> 205 students (SUU campus)¹³, 317 students (UT campus)¹⁴

- Other safety and security personnel needs identified by the school safety needs assessment (53G-8-701.5(2)(a)(ii)): Both SUU SUCCESS Academy and UT SUCCESS Academy performed a needs assessment last year and will conduct another assessment later this year to comply with HB 84.

Utah Career Path High School (Davis Technical College)

- Relationship with the higher education institution: Davis Technical College authorizes the charter for Career Path High School.¹⁵
- <u>Grades:</u> 9-12
- 2023-2024 School Year Fall Enrollment: 168 students¹⁶

- Other safety and security personnel needs identified by the school safety needs assessment (53G-8-701.5(2)(a)(ii)): Career Path High School completed a safety assessment early in the 2023-2024 school year and will complete another assessment this fall to comply with HB 84. CPH currently employs one school resource officer (Ryan Freeman, ryan.freeman@davistech.edu).
