2025 General Session: The following changes to Title 76, Chapters 9 and 10 proposed for recodification to create uniform subsection structure in offense statutes per the direction of the Criminal Code Subcommittee of the Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Interim Committee.

Subsections were reorganized to match the following order as much as possible:

- Subsection (1) Definitions
- Subsection (2) Elements of offense
- Subsection (3) Penalties
- Subsection (4) Limitations/Defenses
- Subsection (5) etc. Limitations/Defenses cont. or additional information

Notable amendments to create clarity are noted below. Statutes that did not need to be amended based on the standards for this recodification are not included in this chart. In addition, noteworthy amendments to statutes outside of Title 76, Chapters 9 and 10 are included in a separate chart below, including several revisions to statutes from previous Criminal Code Recodification bills. Practitioners and the public should rely on the final language codified in adopted legislation rather than notes in these documents.
