Salt Lake County Property Owner -

Please be aware that you, or someone you know, may qualify for one or more of these property tax relief programs:

- CIRCUIT BREAKER PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT If you own your home, will be age 66
 before January 1, 2024, or are a widow, and had 2022 household income from all sources
 including Social Security, 401K distributions etc, of \$38,369 or less.
- INDIGENT PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT If you own your home, will be age 65 before
 January 1, 2024, or are on Social Security disability, and are unable to pay the taxes on your
 home, you may be eligible.
- HARDSHIP TAX ABATEMENT If you are any age in extreme hardship.
- VETERANS & BLIND EXEMPTIONS If you are a service-connected disabled veteran or are blind or you are the surviving spouse of a service-connected disabled veteran or blind person.
- SENIOR DEFFERAL PROGRAM (NEW) Allows senior homeowners age 75+ who have owned their home for 20 consecutive years or more to defer the accumulated property taxes until the property is sold or is no longer their primary residence.
