Sources of Population Data

U.S. Bureau of the Census (Census)


- Conducts the decennial enumeration
- Prepares annual state population estimates

Utah Population Committee (UPC)

- Created by statute
- Prepares annual state and county population estimates



Statutorily Required Sources





Problem


- Growing divergence between the Census and UPC estimates
- UPC recommended for Utah-only purposes
- Census recommended for comparing to other areas of the U.S.


Question

 Should UPC's estimates be the primary source in statute?

Considerations

 Utah Constitution likely requires that Census data be used for congressional and state legislative redistricting, but otherwise the Legislature may specify a source by statute
