## Title 63G-28

(2) (a) The division shall award grants from the fund to a venue operator to provide funding for construction, improvements, and repairs to a venue.

## Title 63G-28

(6) (a) A venue operator that receives a grant award under this section may only use the grant award to construct, improve, or repair a venue.

Weber County is requesting \$3.8M of previously appropriated funding to add to their \$1M to complete the following projects:

Reconfigure, replace, and upgrade Ice Plant: \$1.8M

Mechanical, equipment, plumbing, and public area upgrades: \$2.8M

Design is complete

The project needs to be completed before March 2026 in preparation to host the 2026 Curling World Championship (an Olympic qualifying event).
