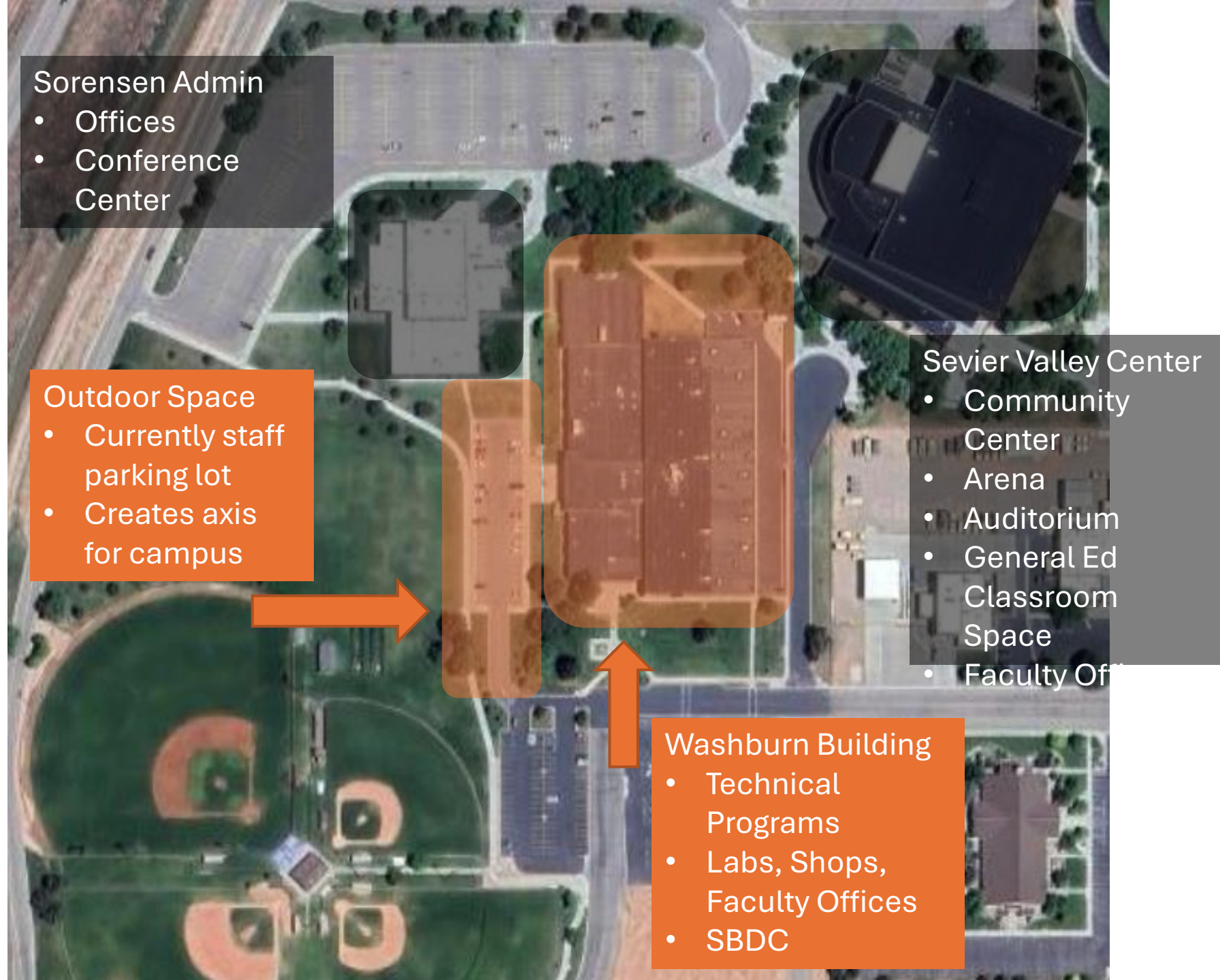

- *Outdoor Engagement Space*



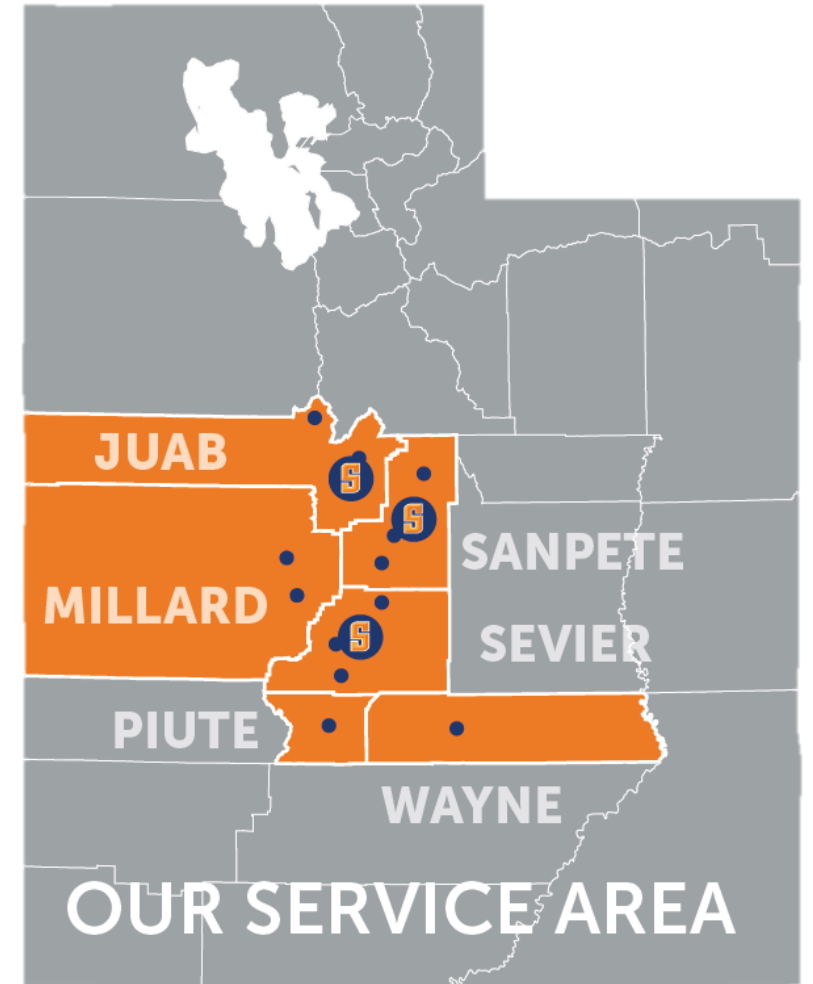
WASHBURN BUILDING

- Main classroom building
- Established as Sevier Valley ATC in 1961
- Moved into Washburn Building in 1977
- Designed as commuter campus with siloed programming
- Limited gathering spaces for student activities, both indoors and outside
- Not designed for student connections



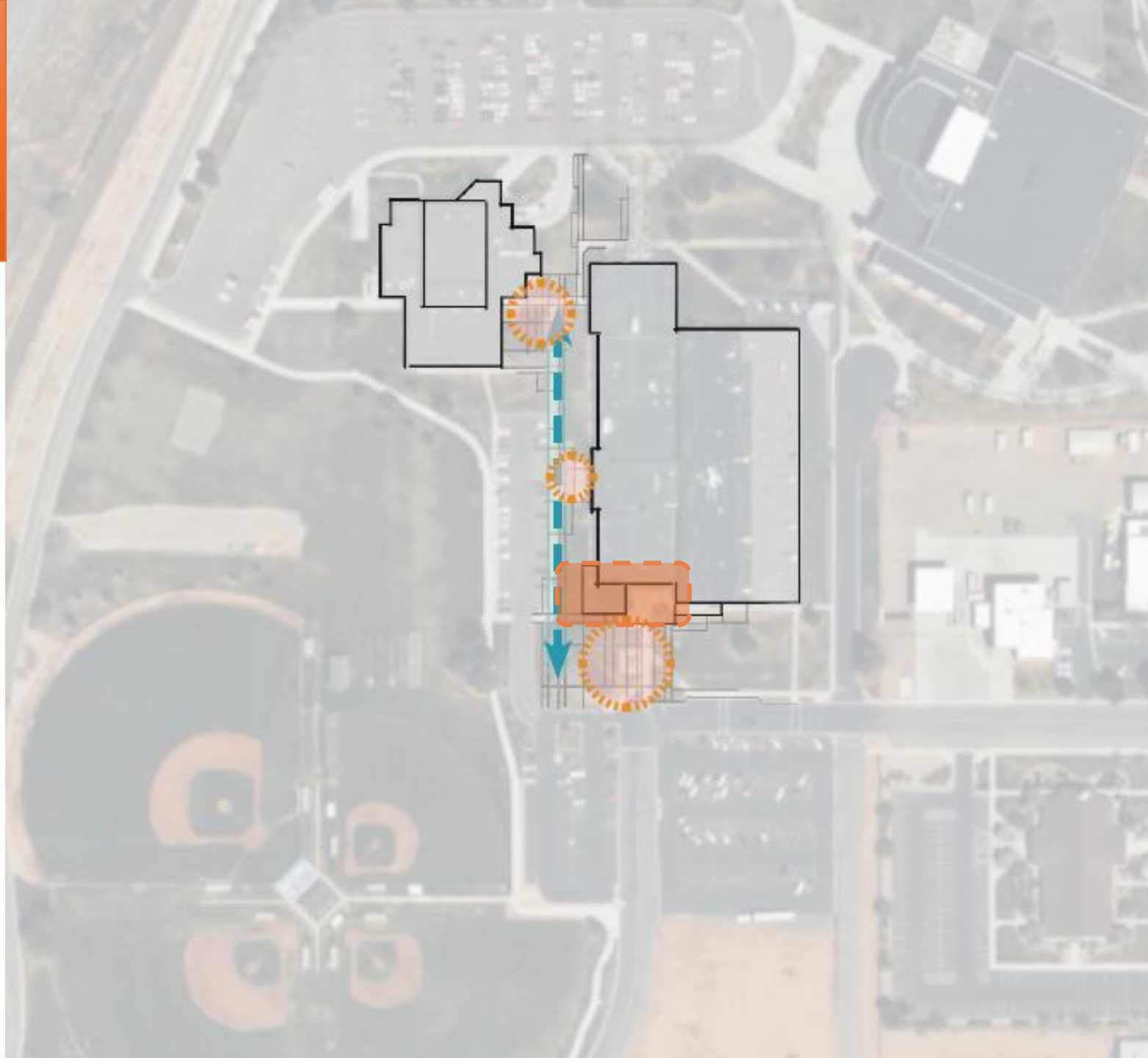
SNOW'S MISSION ON THE RICHFIELD CAMPUS

- Key to Snow's role as a technical college
- Added robust general education offerings
- Added four athletic teams
- Leased two apartment buildings for student housing
- Large service area requires housing
- ~30% of post-high students live on campus
- Invested in student leadership: student officers, ambassadors, wellness advocates, peer mentors, RAs
- Student connections help with retention, mental health, well-being – need a space for this



INDOOR AND OUTDOOR SPACE

- Entrance to campus
- Gateway to Main Street
- Visibility from I-70
- Elevate profile of tech ed in central Utah
- Includes outdoor space development – never created on Richfield campus
