- Built in 1968
- 19,800 sq. ft.
- Efficient classroom building
- Replacement value = \$10 M



McDonald Building Remodel & Addition

- 28,700 sq. ft. addition
- 48,500 sq. ft. total
- \$564 per sq. ft.
- \$27,367,000 = project
- \$407,700 = O&M


- Home for 3-D Sculpture/Ceramics, Art Entertainment & Animation, Painting/Drawing Illustration, Photography/Digital Imaging
- Expansion for the BFA and MFA
- Enhanced space for high-growth programs, such as photography and animation
- Brings the Art Department back into the heart of our campus, connecting art students with their peers throughout the main campus
- Opportunities for art display and campus/community engagement

Demolish North Plaza

- Built in 1969
- Old Snow's, Gibson's, and Harmon's grocery stores
- Across busy street from the main campus
- Not purpose-built for higher education
- Wood construction without insulation







- Classrooms relocated back to main campus
- 100 South is barrier & dangerous to cross
- Remodel of McDonald
- Demo old classroom Buildings
- Addition of 350 parking stalls to support student housing
