















COMPARISON OF ACADEMIC PEERS



OPERATING MARGIN HISTORY


OPERATING MARGIN IS THE MAIN FUNDING SOURCE FOR UUHC

Academic support funds research & education.


Research and education are critical to the mission of University of Utah Health. Funding of these missions is used to advance clinical care and educate future health care providers.

COMPARISON OF ACADEMIC PEERS


