Requested on-going funds will be used to host professional foreign delegations that facilitate the exchange of best practices between government, business, and community leaders in Utah and their counterparts across the world. The requested one-time funds will be used to enhance workforce readiness through a state-wide career development program that strengthens young adults' professional skills and directly connects them to employment opportunities in international relations. For 60 years, Utah Global Diplomacy has worked as Utah's private sector partners and the U.S. State Dept, to host more than 400 foreign dignitaries from 120 countries in Utah.

Utah is a top destination for foreign dignitaries due to our economic strength, spirit of innovation, focused rural economic support, and our reputation for good governance, and spirit of giving. These exchange programs are a long-term investment in cultivating productive professional and personal relationships between Utah business, government and nonprofit leaders and their counterparts across the globe. These relationships can result in best practice exchanges and joint venture opportunities.

How will the Legislature know whether the project or program achieved its intended purpose?

Utah Global Diplomacy will measure the success in the following ways: 1. Generate more than \$1,500,000 in economic impact for the state of Utah by supporting local businesses. 2. Brand Utah globally and increase Utah's international presence to more than 120 countries. 3. Connect 100 Utah businesses, nonprofits, government agencies, schools, and faith organizations to international partners. 4.
