### Who would benefit the most from this request (who is the target audience)?

This request would benefit children in Title I schools, families below the 200% federal poverty level, rural communities, and Native American communities.



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### What is this project or program intended to accomplish?

This program is intended to increase access to affordable, professional vision care for underserved populations in Utah, particularly low-income children and families in rural and economically disadvantaged areas. By expanding the EyeCare4Kids mobile vision clinic's reach, the program will provide 20,000 annual vision services, addressing unmet needs and ensuring timely, effective interventions to improve eye health and overall well-being. In turn, the program aims to enhance children's success in school by improving their ability to see clearly, which is critical for learning and academic performance.

## How will the Legislature know whether the project or program achieved its intended purpose?

Success will be measured by the number of services provided and the improvements in access to vision care in rural and underserved areas. A short-term target will be the delivery of at least 7,000 vision care services within the first six months of the program's expansion. Additionally, tracking patient satisfaction will provide insight into the quality and effectiveness of the services. Progress will also be assessed through outreach efforts, such as the number of schools and community organizations engaged in the program.
