In another recent survey, a majority of Utahns said showing a photo ID when they return their ballot would increase their confidence in Utah elections.





How we plan to introduce ID verification to our vote-by-mail system:

Every Utahn who is eligible to vote in an election will continue to get a ballot in the mail

When returning a ballot, voters have two options:

Return the ballot to a polling location drop box and present your ID to a poll worker when dropping off the ballot

Opt in to return ballots by mail, by verifying ID with the county clerk in person

This process will keep Utah's voting system convenient, accessible, and secure.
