

HB138 FOOD LABELING AMENDMENTS

This bill

1. Requires beef, chicken, pork, fish, and seafood to be labeled accurately
2. Defines "cultivated meat product"
3. Defines "plant or insect-based meat substitute"
4. Requires disclosure to consumers if a food contains a cultivated meat product, insect-based meat substitute, or a plant-based meat substitute
5. Fiscal note is \$50,500 one time and \$4,300 ongoing



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This bill does NOT

1. Prohibit the manufacture, cultivation, or sale of cultivated meat, plant, or insect-based meat substitutes
