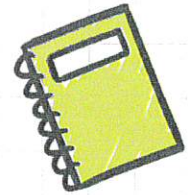

H.B. 191 HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT AMENDMENTS

CLEAR STANDARDS FOR LEARNING:

- THE BILL ENSURES PACKET-BASED COURSES HAVE SUFFICIENT RIGOR, GIVING STUDENTS ACCESS TO QUALITY MATERIALS FOR INDEPENDENT LEARNING.

STATE BOARD RULES:

- STATE BOARD WILL ESTABLISH RULES FOR USE OF PACKETS TO AWARD ORIGINAL & REPLACEMENT CREDIT.

LEA APPROVAL:

- LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCIES (LEA) CAN AWARD CREDIT FOR PACKET-BASED COURSES IF THE PACKET ADHERES TO THE STATE BOARD RULES.

FAIR AND EQUITABLE GRADING:

- PACKET-BASED REPLACEMENT CREDIT IS PASS-FAIL, GIVING STUDENTS THE ABILITY TO MAKE UP CREDIT, WHILE NOT CREATING AN INCENTIVE FOR STUDENTS TO AVOID WORK DURING THE ORIGINAL COURSE.

What Does this Bill Do?



This bill removes obstacles in Utah for military personal and veterans who are seeking higher education

Which institutions/persons are eligible?



The higher education would be provided by state-funded institutions. This would decrease restrictions for active, reserve, and national-guard military personal, as well as veterans that have left the service with a honorable or general discharge

Why Support this Bill?



This allows for people service members to receive education faster and easier than before
