RULES.

FAIR AND EQUITABLE GRADING:

 PACKET-BASED REPLACEMENT CREDIT IS PASS-FAIL, GIVING STUDENTS THE ABILITY TO MAKE UP CREDIT, WHILE NOT CREATING AN INCENTIVE FOR STUDENTS TO AVOID WORK DURING THE ORIGINAL COURSE.
