




#### PLANNING TIMELINE

- Summer & Fall 2024: Budget cut exercise.
- December 2024 February 2025: Modeled a 10% instructional budget cut.
- March 2025: Analyzed data and opportunities for disinvestment; received USHE guidance; sought USU community input.
- April 2025: Deliberated disinvestment and reinvestment recommendations; announced college restructure and program credential cuts.
- May 2025: Drafted strategic reinvestment plan and submitted to USHE.

#### Program Elimination:

Eliminate instructional programs that attract lower student enrollment, including emphases, certificates, associate, bachelor, master, and doctorate degrees.

#### Program Effectiveness:

Reduce departmental expenditures for areas with lower graduation rates and professional outcomes.

#### Cost-efficient Instruction & Programming:


Rightsize department size, scope, programs, and resources by reducing reliance on adjuncts, increasing full-time teaching loads, and finding efficiencies in instructional efforts.

#### • Administrative Efficiency:

Make administrative cuts, department restructuring, overhead reduction, position eliminations.




### FOUR AREAS OF DISINVESTMENT








### **DISINVESTMENT BY COLLEGE**






# FTE DISINVESTMENT BY EMPLOYEE CLASSIFICATION












## STATUTORY MINIMUM IMPLMENTATION TIMELINE FOR HB 265
