Identity, Inherent in the Individual

- ▷ SB260, enacted during the 2025 General Session, codified a framework for State-Endorsed Digital Identity (SEDI), which:
 - Confirms that identity is inherent in an individual.
 - Clarifies that the role of the state is to endorse digital identity, but does not create identity.
 - Directs the Department of Government Operations to explore implementation of a SEDI program and system.
- Implementation of a SEDI program must be expressly authorized by the Legislature.



Hierarchy of Values

- ▷ SEDI program and system requirements are established and prioritized according to a *hierarchy of values*.
- The highest values are:
 - The protection of individual rights (including privacy).
 - Safeguarding children and the vulnerable.
 - Strengthen families and communities.
- Operational goals such as interoperability, efficiency, convenience, or private-industry profits are recognized as legitimate but subordinate to the *highest values* and do not justify compromising them.
