Title 63I, Chapter 1, Part 2, Repeal Dates Requiring Committee Review by Title, lists statutes and agencies in the Utah Code that are on a reauthorization schedule and subject to a review by an interim committee. Absent further action by the Legislature, these provisions scheduled for termination will be repealed on their noted repeal date. At the onset of the 2024 interim period, the Legislative Management Committee assigned interim committees¹ to conduct a sunset review of provisions approaching scheduled termination on the reauthorization schedule to determine if the provisions should be made permanent, reauthorized for up to 10 years, with or without amendments, or allowed to expire. This report identifies the outcome of the interim committees' sunset reviews:

- **Remove Repeal Date** – remove the provision scheduled for termination from the reauthorization schedule with legislation that removes the repeal date.
- **Extend Repeal Date** – extend the repeal date of the statute or agency scheduled for termination on the reauthorization schedule.
- **Repeal** – Absent further action by the Legislature, these provisions will be repealed on the noted repeal date.
