


HB227 Student Journalist Amendments (Moss, C.)

Protecting student journalists' rights and teaching professional standards of journalism have bipartisan roots nationally and have garnered support from legislators of both parties in many states.



18 states with laws that protect Student Journalists:

Arkansas, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nevada, New Jersey, North Dakota, Oregon, Rhode Island, Vermont, Washington, and West Virginia
