Section 4: Performance Outcome Measurement

Who would benefit the most from this request (who is the target audience)?

Utahns at risk for, currently experiencing, or who are in recovery from an opioid use disorder are the target audience. Programming is designed to reach rural and frontier Utahns as well as youth and young adults by supporting telehealth and in person services based in Ogden, Provo, and Park City offices.



What is this project or program intended to accomplish?

Jacky's Recovery Support Services Programming is intended to 1) prevent opioid use, especially by young people, through outreach, education, and social connectedness, 2) improve the wellbeing and functioning of people with an opioid use disorder through the provision of clinical services, and 3) to help people maintain recovery from an opioid use disorder through the provision of recovery supports.

How will the Legislature know whether the project or program achieved its intended purpose?

To determine success, JRSS will track the number of services provided by geographic area and the number of unique individuals served. For individuals receiving clinical services, we will track engagement in care as well as using substance use recovery and wellbeing outcome measures including the ASAM, the SURE, and/or the OQ 30.2.
