Who would benefit the most from this request (who is the target audience)?

All patients who are opioid dependant as well as patients who are prescribed opioids while awaiting a surgical procedure.

What is this project or program intended to accomplish?

The pilot is intended to demonstrate that this OUD treatment protocol is effective with heavily impacted patient subgroups, including rural communities, veterans, corrections and pre-op patients.

How will the Legislature know whether the project or program achieved its intended purpose?

By the end of 2026, results of the pilot will be reported to the Department of Health, the HHS Interim Committee, and participating health administration organizations: county health departments, the VA hospital, state and/or county corrections and participating hospitals.
