

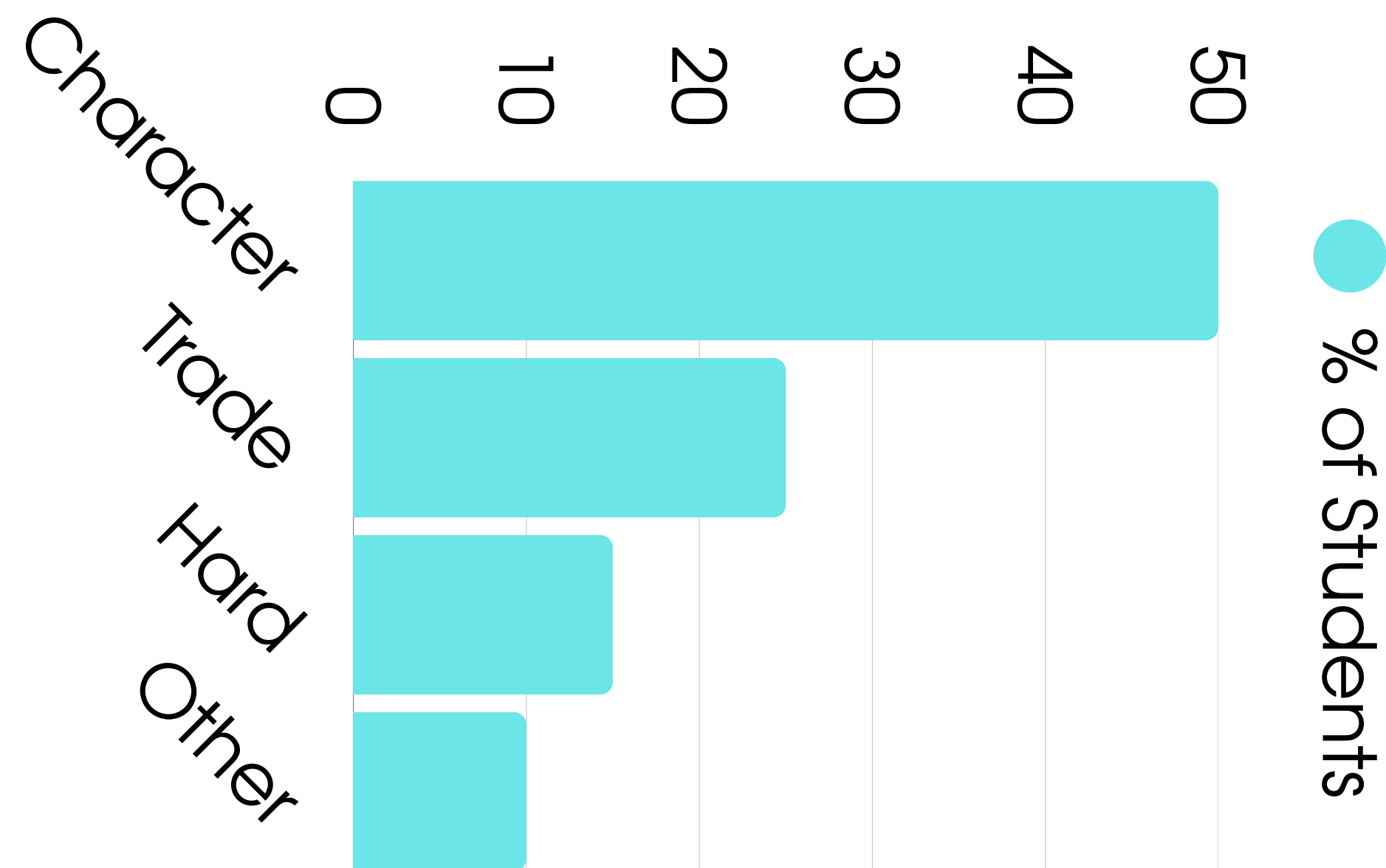

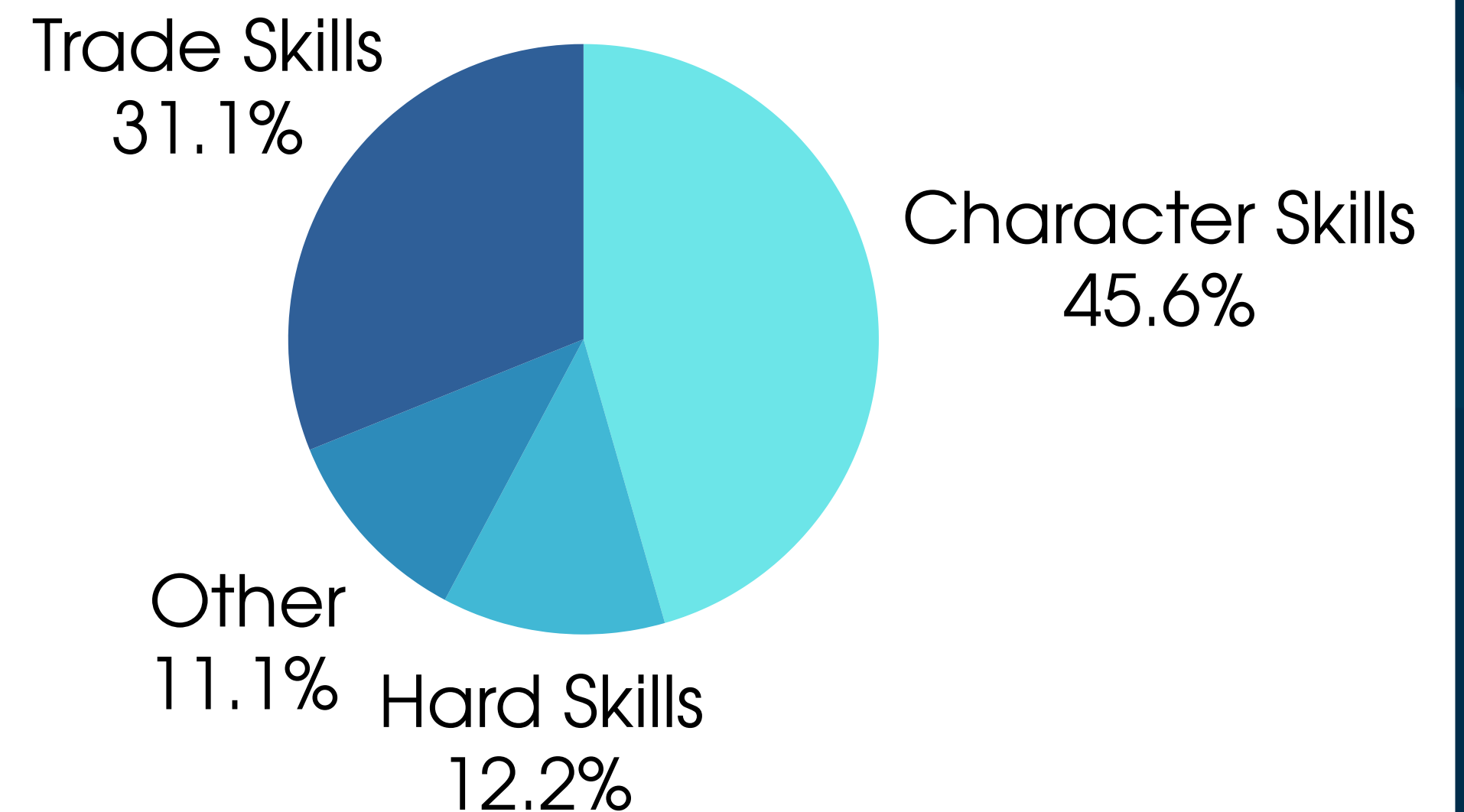

Taking responsibility and following through.

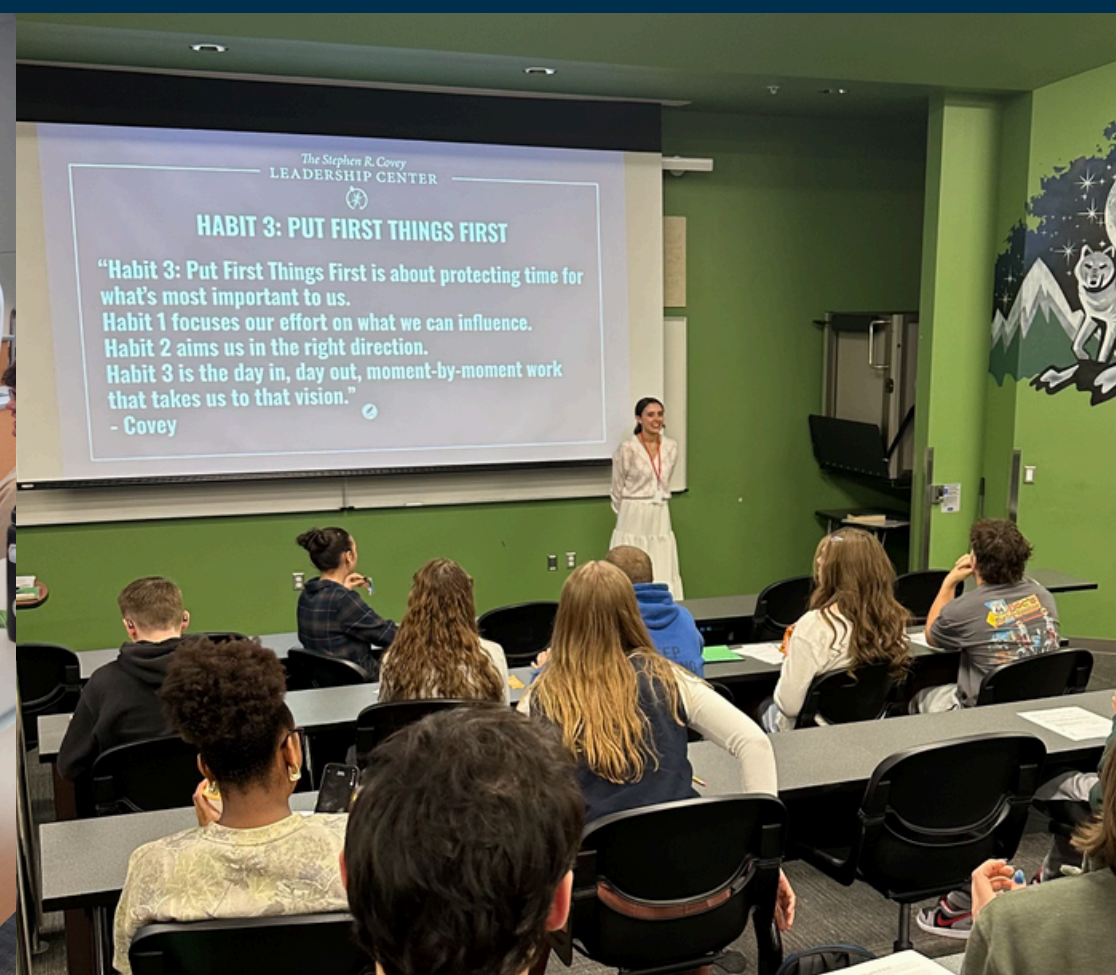
