THE 5 PHASES



We are HERE

Phase 1: Get Started

Key community leaders attend an orientation provided by a CTC specialist in the community. With Key Leader support, the community can begin implementing CTC.

Phase 2: Get Organized

The community forms a Community Board and recruit's members. The Community Board is lead through an orientation to:

- Learn about prevention science
- Write a vision statement
- Organize workgroups
- Develop a timeline for installing CTC

Phase 3: Develop a Community Profile

Workgroups assess community risks and strengths and then identifies existing resources:

- Review data from the SHARP survey
- Identify priority risk and protective factors that predict targeted health & behavior problems
- Assess community resources that address these factors
- Identify gaps to be filled in existing resources

Phase 4: Create a Community Action Plan

The Community Board creates a plan for prevention work in their community to:

- Reduce widespread risk and strengthen protection
- Define clear, measurable outcomes using assessment data
- Select and expand tested and effective policies and programs

Phase 5: Implement & Evaluate

The coalition implements selected programs and policies, monitors and evaluates them, and measures results and tracks progress to ensure improvements are achieved.

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

The Social Development Strategy (SDS) is the foundation of effective prevention work and a key component of our coalition effort. It is an evidence-based framework which organizes protective factors into a simple strategy for promoting positive youth development. The SDS can be applied in individual interactions, throughout programs, and across systems.
