Compile data with attendance to programs, initiating pre and post surveys. Using 2025 SHARP data as a baseline, we are looking to increase protective factors and decrease risk factors. Examples of risk factors in Murray are parental attitudes, low commitment to school and peer/individual attitudes favorable to antisocial behaviors.
