

H.B. 347 ARTIFICIAL TURF PLACEMENT MODIFICATION

WHAT THE BILL DOES

- Requires an advance notice to all property owners or residents within 200 feet of the proposed artificial turf installation
- Requires written notice 30 days before the governing board meeting where the project will be discussed and for it to be posted on the LEA's website 60 days before the meeting
- Public comment shall be allowed at the regular board meetings
- The LEA shall document compliance with all notice and posting requirements

NOTIFICATION RADIUS

- A fixed 200-foot notification radius from the outer edge of the field
- Applies to any artificial turf installed on a field of 5,000+ sq. ft.

WHAT MUST BE INCLUDED IN A NOTICE

- Project location and size
- Type of turf and infill
- Intended use
- Notification radius
- Meeting date/time/location
- Contact information for additional questions
- Link to online updates and project documents

WHAT THE BILL DOES NOT DO

- Does not ban artificial turf installations
- Does not require environmental studies or testing
- Does not apply when turf is being removed or replaced
