## Spousal Support

Currently spousal support is not collected after child support ends. HB 248 would **allow ORS to continue to collect spousal support** until it is no longer enforceable or the one receiving support requests the office no longer collects. This collection would follow the same procedure as child support.

## Office of Recovery Services Feedback

Requires ORS to host group meetings with parents paying or receiving support at least twice per year. **This will provide frontline feedback** to ORS on how they are doing.

## TANF and Child Support

When a custodial parent receives help through a TANF grant, the state then intercepts and keeps any child support the parent is given. HB 248 **passes \$100 to a single child or \$200 for two or more children** from those child support payments onto the parent.

## Drivers License Suspension

If an individual is behind (at least \$35,000) and hasn't made a full payment in 60 days, their **drivers license may be suspended**.

## Xchange Database

Tries to ensure that parties to a custody case know that they are able to **review open court cases in other courts** that may affect the outcome of the custody decision, including through the Xchange database.

## Interest Charges

Starting July 2027, interest will be collected on delinquent child support.

- **6% interest rate**
- Only accrues on principal amount owed
