Re: Revenue Estimates after 2026 G.S. and Economic Issues

Each year, in the first interim Executive Appropriations Committee meeting, you adopt final revenue estimates after legislative actions taken during the last completed general session. The adopted estimates are used to determine revenue surpluses or budget deficits as defined in the Budgetary Procedures Act, [UCA 63J Chapter 1, Part 3](#). For your May 19, 2026 meeting, these estimates will be based on the February 2026 estimates you adopted during the 2026 General Session, with adjustments resulting from bills and appropriations changes passed during the session.

Also, at your May 19 meeting, we will present additional information on revenue collections to date and the overall economy.
