Beginning July 1, 2028, the division shall report on board-established fees, total fee revenue, solar panel waste volumes entering state landfills, division-supported disposal or recycling programs, and any legislative recommendations related to solar panel waste disposal.

The director shall, upon finding that the director cannot adequately oversee existing and additional facilities for permit compliance, monitoring, and enforcement, suspend acceptance of further applications for a commercial nonhazardous solid or hazardous waste facility and report the suspension to the NRAE Interim Committee.

Total Maximum Daily Load Review

The Water Quality Board shall submit the total maximum daily load for review if the total maximum daily load requires a public or private expenditure of more than \$10,000,000 but less than \$100,000,000. If there is a suspension of a facility, the director of the Water Quality Board shall report on any suspensions.
