UServeUtah: One Utah Service Fellowship

The One Utah Service Fellowship was created to provide meaningful service opportunities to young adults, support career development and address high-priority needs within the state.

One Utah Service Fellowship

- State led service program, that is also an AmeriCorps State program.
- As youth finish high school and explore interests and career development, they can participate in the Fellowship program.
- Often paired with and complimenting a degree based program, but can also be for young adults who are exploring their career path.
- Operating in 26 counties, serving in healthcare fields and supporting nonprofits and government agencies with capacity building.

One Utah Service Fellowship

- Unique funding model that braids state, federal, philanthropic and cost share revenue funding streams to create more impact in scope and scale as well as have a more sustainable program model.
- Garners national attention from several other state service commissions, nonprofits and the federal funding agency.
- 1,250 Fellowships filled
- 439,824 hours served for a volunteer return on investment of \$15,600,557
- Additional 15,275 volunteers recruited or managed by the Fellows
